NEW PILOTING PHASE FOR YOUTH WORKERS ONLINE TRAINING



After a successful piloting of the first version of the online training, where youth workers from all participating countries completed the 40-hour program and provided valuable feedback, the partners have identified strengths and weaknesses. Based on these insights, they have revised the content and decided to launch a new piloting phase to engage even more youth workers.

The current opportunity is available on <u>SALTO Youth</u>, and an <u>introductory webinar session</u> will take place on April 29th. Additionally, translations into multiple languages are in progress to ensure broader accessibility.



The Green Workforce Adaptation (GWfA) Methodology is now finalised, and each country is moving into the Local Projects implementation phase. Designed to help participants to apply the knowledge and skills gained during the online training in real-world contexts, the methodology supports assessing local green job markets, identifying key competencies, and addressing workforce challenges. By engaging stakeholders and testing strategies, these initiatives aim to refine best practices and foster sustainable employment opportunities in the green economy.

OF THE GWFA METHODOLOGY

LTTA AND TPM IN PATRAS, GREECE



From March 17th to 20th, the partners convened in Patras, Greece, for the first Learning and Teaching Training Activity (LTTA) and the third Transnational Project Meeting (TPM). Alongside 12 selected youth workers from all five partner countries, they underwent intensive training in the GWFA methodology and developed plans for implementing local projects. The event brought together future career counselors, facilitators, and educators committed to guiding young people toward green careers. During the partner meeting, participants exchanged feedback from the training sessions, provided updates on current activities, and aligned next steps for continued project progress.

>>> WEBINAR - INTRODUCTION TO THE GRECO TRAINING PLATFORM

>>> FINAL TRASNATIONAL MEETING, SERBIA

Partners will gather in Kragujevac, Serbia, for the final dissemination event to reflect on the project's outcomes and agree on the final steps for its closure
